SAL Secretary's report for 2024

94 teams participated in the league this year, which ran smoothly. However, the officials were an issue again in the lower divisions.

60 matches were scheduled but only 58 occurred this year, with no clubs using the September date. Div 3 has 6 leagues as clubs prefer local competition instead of travelling far for matches.

Simon Fennell's portal system was used for declaring teams, Non scorers and officials this year, which were then downloaded into the old SAL software Excel sheets. The portal went down on two occasions causing a huge amount of disruption to team declarations and then the results software and Simon had to work to fix the issues.

Composite clubs have been submitted for the 2024 season, we have 12 clubs now and a link to the document has been added to the league website so everyone can see this under the documents tab.

6 Treasurer's Report

2024 Treasurer's Report

31 matches used photo-finish in 2024 (24 in 2023, 34 in 2022, 29 in 2021, 31 in 2019 and 2018 – there were fewer matches in the last couple of years and photo-finish was used in about 53% of the matches in 2024, which has increased since the approximately 37-39% in previous years). The current subsidy for a match involving photo-finish is £200 and 30 matches have been refunded (pending refunds are awaiting for confirmation of bank details). I would recommend to keep the refund to the same for 2025, but mandate the SAL committee to review the amount for 2026 onwards, should be number of matches with photo-finish decrease to levels before 2024.

At 6 th November, 54 clubs (out of 94) have paid their membership fees for 2025. Enrolment to the next season is ongoing.

In 2021, we received a fund of £3,000 from EA to pay for L1 and L2 official courses for SAL clubs (maximum two L1 officials and one L2 per club) – This year, we have not refund any course, so we still have just over £1,250 available for official courses going forward.

There has been a profit of £1,390.00 this year, which is about £800 less than the previous year: this is in line with the increase of matches with photofinish and the subsequent increase in refunds. In light of this, I would recommend to keep the membership fee at £75 for the 2025 as well.

Overall, we have a healthy balance, which should help the league running for the next few years.
